Biographies

Musical Director:

Charlotte Şinassi - Hill



Charlotte is a composer, choir director and music educationalist. Born in London, she gained a scholarship to the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, later studying at the Royal College of Music and Goldsmiths' College, University of London. Charlotte lectured in music education at the University of Cambridge, and is much in demand as an adjudicator, enjoying a busy schedule of examining for the ABRSM, both in the UK and overseas. As a composer, Charlotte receives regular

commissions from a variety of sources, but her main interest is writing for voices. Under Charlotte's dynamic leadership, King's Lynn Community Choir is enjoying an ever diverse repertoire, collaborating with local musicians and artists and growing in local reputation.

David studied organ and piano at the Royal College of Music, Kingston University and later post-graduate studies in organ at Goldsmiths College, University of London. He currently, predominantly, works as a psychotherapist but continues his involvement with music as an organist, accompanist and piano teacher.

Lewis Meehan, our timpanist this evening, is a student at Springwood High School, where he studies orchestral percussion with Charlie Westbrook, and plays in the school's big band and concert band. He is currently principal percussionist at Norfolk Symphony Orchestra and has also performed



with many other local orchestras, taking part in the National Youth Percussion Orchestra this summer. He's a member of PercWorks, a group which has also taken part in performances at the Royal Albert Hall and the Royal College of Music. Lewis is planning to prepare to study percussion at conservatoire. Tonight, Lewis is joined on percussion by two fellow students at SHS, Charlize and Chantelle.

Norfolk Symphony Orchestra Alongside Lewis, and members of King's Lynn Town Band, our small orchestra is made up of local musicians, many of whom play in the Norfolk Symphony Orchestra. This is their first collaboration with the Community Choir and we extend a heartfelt welcome and thanks to them for their support.
